### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What has been the most impactful lesson you've taken from the Chasing David series?
2. Which event in David's life was most memorable for you, and why?
3. Which components of this series (books, video devo's, small group videos, small group discussions, sermons) were most helpful to you?
4. Where do you find your confidence in life?
  - Do you find more confidence in GOD things, or GOOD things?
  - Why is it sometimes easier to put confidence in GOOD things more than GOD things?
  - What is the word for anything that we put in the place of God?
  - Why is it important to put our confidence in GOD things (ie His presence, power, promises, etc.), not GOOD things (a spouse, financial provisions, safety, security, your kids, etc.)?
5. Read Psalm 27:1-6. In what ways does David find confidence in the fact that God is ALWAYS WITH HIM?
  - What do you notice about his confidence in relation to his circumstances?
  - Where do you need the reminder TODAY that God is ALWAYS with you?
6. Read Psalm 27:7-13. In What ways does David find confidence in the fact that God is ALWAYS WORKING?
  - Where do YOU need the reminder/hope/encouragement today that God is ALWAYS WORKING?
  - Where do you need God to work on an “inside-out” situation? A “family” situation? An “outside-in” situation?
7. Read Psalm 27:14, and Isaiah 64:4. What is something you are waiting for in your life?
8. Have you ever waited for God before, and after a period of waiting, He answered? Share the story.
9. Why do you feel God is ALWAYS WORTH WAITING FOR?
