- Leading and developing interns toward greater leadership in ministry
- Planning curriculum and presenting relevant biblical messages to help students develop a biblical worldview

Secondary Responsibilities

- Supporting the mission of CPC and adhering to its personnel guidelines
- Managing the calendar of events and the budget for the ministry
- Connecting with students relationally for discipleship and support
- Meeting with other staff and leaders to provide ongoing encouragement and guidance
- Attending and supporting department meetings, training events, church staff meetings
- Maintaining effective communications with students, leaders, and parents and help promote the visibility of your ministry to the congregation
- Seeking your own personal growth spiritually and professionally
- Working collaboratively with other departments of the church
