INTRODUCTION

God chooses the most unlikely people to accomplish the most amazing things. As we look at the story of Gideon, we see a great example of how God can use us to accomplish great things.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Discuss a time when God used you in ways that exceeded your expectations.
- 2. Read Judges chapter 6
 - a. We read that the Israelites, God's chosen people, came under severe oppression by the Midianites. It was never God's plan or intention for them to live under such bondage. In Judges 6:10 we read how they got themselves into this situation.
 - b. Discuss some of the ways they got themselves into this situation.
- 3. Throughout the Bible it's clear that God's people often missed out on His promises and purposes when their hearts were given to idols. The same is true today.
 - a. Identify and discuss with your group some of the idols in our culture. (Discussion note: many of the good and wonderful blessings in our lives can become idols if we treasure them more than God.)
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17
 - a. Discuss with your group why we find it so difficult sometimes to see ourselves the way God sees us?
- 5. Read Judges 6:22
 - a. When do you see that Gideon had a transformation from fear to faith?
 - b. Where do you need peace in your life today? What worship song is speaking to your heart in this season of life?
- 6. Read Psalm 73:26, Jeremiah 24:7, Ezekiel 36:26, Romans 8:28. Which one of these verses encourages you and gives you hope for 2019? Share your reason why.
