EVERYBODY ALWAYS “Everybody Always Loves”

Guest Speaker, Christian Huang // September 22-23, 2018

INTRODUCTION

This week we continue our EVERYBODY ALWAYS series--fueled by the inspiration to love everybody always...and leading up to our 3rd annual SERVE DAY weekend on October 6-7. Today we have a Special Guest Speaker, Christian Huang. He is the founder of Mobilize Love, a city-wide mobile outreach for children, youth, and families in San Francisco.

Mobilize Love deploys a fleet of outreach trucks (mobile kitchen, mobile barbershop, laundry truck, and sidewalk church truck) to give underprivileged families access to basic human services and the good news of Jesus.

WARMING UP

- 1 Share with one another one thing that you love about Jesus.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Our relationship with Jesus is more important than any other relationship in our life. Why?
2. So why do you think it is so difficult to find time on our calendar to spend time with Jesus?
3. Read Matthew 22:35-40 (NIV). What is the most important command? Why? This brings us to our first point.
 - a. **Remain in Christ.** Talk about this as a group. What does it look like to remain in Christ?
4. Read Matthew John 15:9-13 (NIV). In verse 10, what will happen if you keep his commands? And in verse 11, why has He told us this? Discuss as a group what it means to have your joy be complete.
5. **What is LOVE? Why LOVE?** Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-3 (NIV).
 - a. How do you feel when someone does something kind for you, but clearly they do not LOVE doing this kind deed?
 - b. What does genuine LOVE look like?
6. This brings us to the second point.
 - a. **Harness the Fire of God's Love.** Remember what was said in today's message? "The source of love is _____ Himself. And to truly harness the fire of love, we must remain in _____. If you don't remember, the answers are GOD and HIM.

7. Once we harness the fire of God's love, we have to...
 - a. **Mobilize Love.** This is the third point. What good is love unless it is delivered?
 - b. Read John 3:16-17 (NIV). What are the things God did to show love?
 - c. How can we mobilize love? Talk about it as a group.

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 The Message (MSG)

3-7 If I give everything I own to the poor and even go to the stake to be burned as a martyr, but I don't love, I've gotten nowhere. So, no matter what I say, what I believe, and what I do, I'm bankrupt without love.
