Kerri has been on the path to stardom since she was a child, and at just age 11 was well on her way to becoming a professional dancer when she was diagnosed with scoliosis. She underwent painful treatments, which eventually culminated in a spinal fusion surgery. She could now live a normal life, but her dreams of a dance career were over.

Devastated but determined, young Kerri got out the phone book and called the local theater company. She auditioned and was cast in the lead role of Mary Tilford in Lillian Hellman's *The Children's Hour*.

In her 20s, Kerri pursued the Hollywood dream of landing the one role that would make her famous and leave her feeling fulfilled. But she soon learned that the pursuit of a star on Hollywood's Walk of Fame was not worth compromising her standards. She decided to enter the world of standup comedy so she would have the ability to create her own content and share stories and messages to inspire and bring joy to her audiences.

Since then, she has become one of the most sought-after comedians in the country and has shared the stage with Sherri Shepherd of *The View*, Jim Carrey, Jay Leno, Carol Channing and many others. Kerri is also an accomplished actress, with credits that include 29 appearances on NBC's *The Tonight Show*, Comedy Central and recurring roles on the *Port Charles, General Hospital*, and *The Young and the Restless*. Currently, you can see her on Nick at Nite's Moms Night Out and on the popular web series *MOMLAND*. In June of 2014, Kerri appeared on *The Hour of Power*, which has a viewership of 42 million.

Her film credits include starring in the award-winning documentary, *Hollywood on Fire*, with Pat Boone, and *La La Land*, which premiered in NYC and LA. Kerri appears in the recently released and critically acclaimed documentary *American Jesus*, and now on Netflix *The Brennan Manning Story*.

Kerri is also a popular speaker and is frequently engaged for fundraisers, faith-based events, women's conferences and corporate clients like Ford Motor Company and Cisco Systems. She's hosted the GMA Awards and headlined the red-carpet launch for the prestigious California Women's Conference, with more than 20,000 in attendance. Comedy for All - Stand-up Comedy (for any audience)

Say Yes to God!

Kerri talks about her journey out of being a "type-A" control freak. All about her plans to make it "big" and to be famous in Hollywood, she told God, "When I win an Academy Award, then I'll say your name!" She'll share with the audience how God got her attention and won her heart. She will help others learn how to turn their hopes and dreams to God and take a chance on what His will for their lives. God always has a spectacular ending in mind for each of us if we allow Him into our hearts. This message will encourage people from all walks of life to say "YES!" to God!

God's Not Done With You Yet!

When Kerri first came to L.A., she knew no one and battled loneliness and a sense she would never fit in. What she didn't realize at the time was that her feelings of embarrassment and rejection stemmed from the fact that she was trying to earn God's love. But her life was changed when she formed an unlikely friendship with an 87-year-old woman named Betty, who truly showed her the importance of Titus chapter two. Kerri will share stories from their mission trips, which they, of course, went on to "meet cute boys!" Betty's caring influence caused Kerri to take off her "church mask" and be vulnerable with other Christians. After all, no one is perfect! Betty is 100 years old today, and the two ladies remain close friends and prayer partners.

Tales from A Proverbs 32 Woman (women)

Everyone told Kerri that in order to be loved by God, she had to be like the Proverbs 31 woman. But since she doesn't rise early or plow and has never even been in a field, she felt it didn't speak to her at all. She says her idea of "gathering food from afar" is takeout! She says she's more of a Proverbs 32 woman; she rises late, and her kids make her breakfast! In this message, she shares stories from her own life where she felt she didn't quite measure up to the Christian ideal. She exposes the lie that women need to do and have it all and be perfect while they're at it! She answers questions like:

- If you struggle with control, how do you give up your plans and desires to the Lord?
- How can you feel worthy of God's love?
- Does God really sweat the small stuff? Does he care your child just drew all over your new couch with a marker? Does he care you almost brushed your teeth with diaper cream and haven't showered in three days?
- What do you do when you feel like you can't do it anymore?
- Is there room for mistakes in God's kingdom?

Kerri teaches there's nothing we can do to make God love us more or less. Most haven't experienced this kind of unconditional love, but God wants all of his daughters to know how much he loves them. Kerri hopes to help women find freedom from our performance-driven culture.

Waiting on God...Proactively (singles)

Kerri shares her adventures as a single — when she couldn't quite figure out why she wasn't married with kids yet, as her mother prayed she would be. She often felt "less than" and not quite whole and spent her 20s trying to find Mr. Right. While her search garnered her plenty of material for her comedic roles (she was even once rejected by a popular dating website!), there was also plenty of heartache and life lessons. Sharing stories from her successful books, *Guys Like Girls Named Jennie* and *How to Ruin Your Dating Life*, her hilarious anecdotes will have audiences rolling with laughter while inspiring them to give their dating life over to God. Kerri's message to singles: No, you do NOT have some kind of terminal disease, and unless you make God the first love of your life, there is no earthly relationship that will ever fulfill you.

I Didn't Make Cheerleading (women)

From a young age, Kerri struggled to fit in. As she grew older, she thought the fame Hollywood offered would fill that void in her heart — that desire to *belong*. Even as an adult, Christian woman, there can be pressure to make sure you're sitting at the "popular table." Afraid of rejection, we put on our "church face" and don't let our sisters know we're suffering. Kerri tells women they need to get *real* and be willing to admit to ourselves and others when we struggle. Whether it's depression, anger, grief or loss, we all have scars — God can heal us and we can be strengthened as we help carry one another's burdens.

God Gave You a Boat

All of us experience periods of rough water in life. But surrendering to God is the key to surviving the tsunami of struggles we might face. Kerri knows; she's had to walk side-by-side with her mother as she battled breast cancer multiple times. Drawing from Isaiah 43, she tells audiences if they want to follow the Lord, they have to trust that when they walk through the waters, he is not going to let them drown. The Father will always give us the option of "getting into the boat" with Him. Even when we're on the floor doing the "ugly cry," we can still see God's face if we look for it.

Even as a little girl who didn't quite fit in, Kerri dreamt of fame and fortune. Definitely qualifying as a "strong-willed" child, no one really knew what lay ahead for this quirky kid. After college, she packed up her bags and moved out to Hollywood, much to her mother's dismay. This good little church girl was content to give God about 70% of her life, but when it came to her TV career and her dating life — she wasn't ready to give up that much control! But her family never stopped praying for her, and then one night *everything* changed. Kerri surrendered her entire life over to God and never looked back. Who knew this precocious teen would become a successful comedian and one of the loudest voices for faith in Hollywood? God has a plan for everyone's life — if they're willing to surrender to Him.
