FIRST TAKE

TAKEAWAY

1. Isaiah is prioritizing the sabbath in the equation of Zoe life. Consider why this is so important to him.
2. In John 6, Jesus challenges us to work for real food, true bread that only Jesus gives.
3. The 'work' for every Christian is to simply believe what Jesus believes, especially in regards to provision.
4. Sabbath life is working out of rest instead of resting after we've worked.
