2) Hugh threw it out that Jesus isn't just your Savior but he's the smartest, most wise person that has ever lived. How should that affect your prayer life and how you go about making decisions?

3) Describe a time you felt God's wisdom led you against the dominant voices that were around you. How did you handle that and what happened? Or describe a time you listened to the voices around you instead of God. How did that go?

4) Hugh said, a mark of God's wisdom upon a man is 'stability.' Do you feel stable right now? How can we pray for you today and this week over key decisions you're making?
