Do we always have to wait to get caught before we open up?
3. We are responsible for whether or not desire becomes sinful. When Hugh said that our best play is to be mindful of protecting God's protection over us, what does that look like for you? In other words, what pointers for abiding with Jesus have been the most helpful to you?
