INTRODUCTION

As we finish out our series, Tyler gives us three ways that we must GIVE MORE GRACE AS WE SHELTER IN PLACE with our family. During this time where we are spending so much time with our family, we need to pay attention to the thermostat in our home. Are the attitudes and temperaments getting a bit too hot? Today we will learn how to set the thermostat to GRACE!

1. READ Romans 12:2

- a. Are you being *conformed* or *transformed* during shelter in place?

YOU MUST SET THE THERMOSTAT TO GRACE

2. Grace is like a thermostat; it sets the temperature/tone for your family

- a. What is the temperature of grace in your family right now?
- b. Based on Tyler's message, what are some practical ways you can demonstrate what real grace is—a totally gratuitous gift—to the people in your family.

GIVE THE GIFT OF LOVE

READ 1 Corinthians 13:4-5

- a. Insert your name wherever you see the word "love".
- b. How accurately do these verses describe you?
- c. Which one aspect of love can you focus on growing in this week?

GIVE THE GIFT OF FORGIVENESS

3. READ Colossians 3:13

- a. Why is it so important to forgive?
- b. Is there someone in your family that needs undeserved forgiveness?

GIVE THE GIFT OF ENCOURAGEMENT

4. READ 1 Thessalonians 5:11

- a. How important is it that we encourage one another?
- b. We heard a story by Pastor Ray Johnston where he reminded us that we must also stay encouraged? Why?

CHALLENGE: SHELTER IN GRACE ASSIGNMENT

- Take turns sharing 2 encouraging words about each person with you.
- Send a text, email or call and encourage someone.
- Read Ephesians Chapters 1 through 3.

COMMIT TO MEMORY
